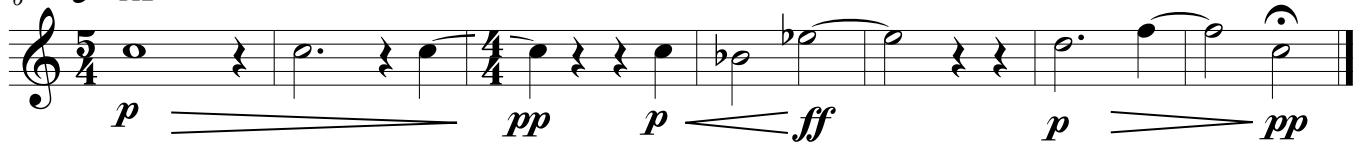

Periods

Are composed of two or more phrases

I. Repetition

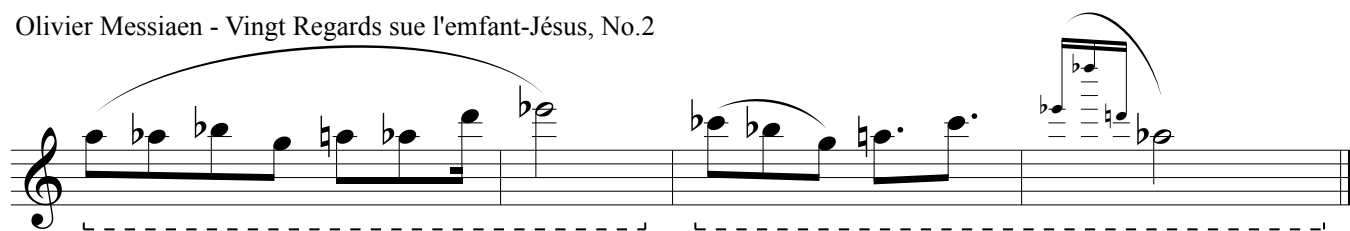
